Bus Information

- Our fleet traveled approximately 175,000 miles 2023-2024 year. This includes different school locations, separate routes in-district, out of district, field trips and sports run.
- Typically, fleet vehicles are replaced when they are 10 years or older and in excess of 100,000 miles driven based on the bus replacement schedule.
 - **The bus that will be replaced for 2025-2026 school year is Bus#98 2017 Blue Bird 72 passenger with 91,222 miles**
